

By 2012 Kettleman Hills Facility (KHF) drastically reduced its annual intake volumes, from 525,000 tons/yr to 12,000 tons/yr, to stay within its overall permitted amounts. Without KHF as an in-state disposal site, up to 75% of hazardous waste generated in California is being sent out-of-state, often to unlined solid waste landfills.
