

WHC CERTIFICATION PHOENIX RESOURCES LANDFILL



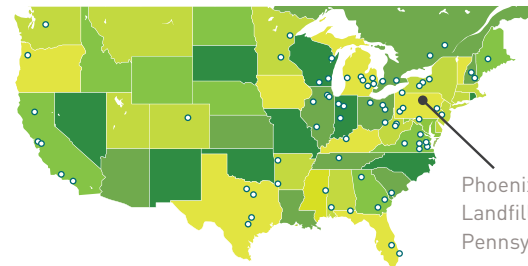
For more than 30 years, WM has partnered with WHC (Wildlife Habitat Council) to enhance and protect thousands of acres to support sustainability programs, biodiversity initiatives and environmental education. By transforming land into certified wildlife habitats, WM is helping communities thrive. At Phoenix Resources Landfill in Wellsboro, Pennsylvania, employees actively manage conservation projects focused on birds, awareness and community engagement and wetlands. **The conservation program at Phoenix Resources Landfill has been WHC-certified since 2010.**

PRACTICES AND IMPACTS

- The cavity-nesting bird box project at Phoenix Resources Landfill provides nest boxes for eastern bluebirds, tree swallows and American kestrels. The project encourages installation and monitoring of existing nest boxes in a suitable habitat throughout the property.
- Team members participate in an annual safety education event that works to ensure all personnel on-site are prepared for potential encounters with native bear species.
- The 5.45-acre three-pond wetland system filters water entering Babb Creek.
