## Service Overview

### Recycling Collection

In accordance with Assembly Bill 341, California's Mandatory Commercial Recycling law, businesses that generate at least 4 cubic yards of solid waste, or multifamily properties with five or more units, must participate in a recycling program by subscribing to recycling services or self-hauling recyclables to an approved facility.



To assist businesses and multifamily properties in complying with AB 341, WM is proud to offer commercial recycling services for Calabasas businesses and multifamily complexes at a reduced rate. Containers are available in a variety of sizes, including 1.5, 3, 4 and 6 cubic yard dumpsters. Roll-off containers and compactor service are also available. To get started, contact Customer Service to schedule a site visit with a Recycling Coordinator.

### Organic Waste Collection

#### Do you generate food waste at your business? We want to hear from you!

California State law, Senate Bill 1383 requires all businesses to recycle organic waste, which includes food waste and green waste. This new law is part of a statewide effort to reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The goal of SB 1383 is to reduce organic waste disposal by 75% by 2025.



In October 2010, WM implemented a commercial food waste program. WM and the City of Calabasas have developed a commercial food waste recycling program that will help the community reach State diversion goals. Our trained employees can help you determine the size container and frequency of service required to meet your needs. ## Trash Collection

Regardless of the size of your business or multifamily property, we can create a customized collection program that meets your needs and protects the environment. Trash containers are available in a variety of sizes, including 1.5, 3, 4 and 6 cubic yard dumpsters. Roll-off containers and compactor service are also available.



## Bin & Cart Service reminders

All containers should be placed in locations that allow easy access and convenient use by customers and are safely accessible to the hauler. Containers should be placed on a paved or hard and level surface whenever possible.

## Electronic or Hazardous Waste

Fluorescent tubes and bulbs, electronics (computers, cell phones, TVs etc.), rechargeable batteries and hazardous products (cleaners, solvents, etc.) do not go in the recycling or trash containers.

## Holiday Schedule

---

Waste collection does not occur on the following holidays:

New Year's Day      Memorial Day      Independence Day      Labor Day      Thanksgiving Day      Christmas Day

When a holiday falls on a weekday, your collection will be delayed by one day for the remainder of the week. If a holiday falls on Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delay in service.

# ORGANICS | RECYCLING | TRASH

Place Organics, Recycling and Trash containers together with proper signage so everyone places the right materials in the right container.

## What Goes in the Organics Container:



- DO NOT INCLUDE:**
- NO LOOSE PLASTIC BAGS
  - NO SERVEWARE/UTENSILS
  - NO PLASTIC CONTAINERS
  - NO FOAM CONTAINERS
  - NO HAZARDOUS WASTE



Ensure food scraps are placed in a plastic bag or paper bag before placing in your organics container.

## What Goes in the Recycling Container:



- DO NOT INCLUDE:**
- NO LOOSE PLASTIC BAGS
  - NO FOAM CONTAINERS
  - NO CLOTHING, FURNITURE OR CARPET
  - NO HAZARDOUS WASTE



Place recyclables directly into your recycling container - **don't bag your recyclables.**

## What Goes in the Trash Container:



- DO NOT INCLUDE:**
- NO ORGANICS/RECYCLABLES
  - NO HAZARDOUS WASTE
  - NO ELECTRONICS
  - NO BATTERIES, TIRES OR PAINT
  - NO FLAMMABLE MATERIAL
