#### Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

WM will not collect solid or liquid HHW. HHW is any product labeled: toxic, poison, combustible, corrosive, flammable, or irritant that is disposed of. HHW examples include paint (latexand oil-based),

pesticides, pool chemicals, batteries, solvents, and explosive items. Chino residents can drop off their HHW on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month excluding the 4th Saturday of December from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the City of Chino Public Works Service Center, located at 5050 Schaefer Avenue, Chino, CA 91710.

#### **Sharps Collection Program**

To order a sharps container, please call WM Customer Care Center (800) 423-9986 and one will be delivered to your home. Once the container has been filled, simply place it in the mail-back box and



give it to your mail carrier. Residents are limited to one (1) container at no charge per calendar year. Additional sharps containers are available at an additional cost (\$5.00). Only one sharps container can be requested at a time.

#### Need another cart?

Additional trash, recycle, and organic waste carts are available for a nominal fee.



Residents with a cracked or broken trash, recycle, or organic waste cart are eligible for a free replacement. Contact WM Customer Care Center (800) 423-9986.





#### Free Bulky Item Collection

If getting rid of junk is on your spring cleaning to-do list, WM can help! Residents with curbside cart service may request the free pick up of household bulky items three (3) times in a calendar year. To schedule this service, visit us online: cityofchino.org/wmbulkyitempickup or contact (800) 423-9986 at least 2 days in advance of your regular collection day.

- Residents may place up to six (6) bulky items per bulky waste collection request.
- Bulky items can include couches, washers, dryers, refrigerators, and electronic waste. (3 electronic items per year)
- Items are to be placed curbside and will be collected on your regular collection day.

As we tidy up our spaces, let's embrace a sustainable approach: give products a second chance before buying new. Before rushing to replace items, consider if they can be repaired, repurposed, or simply refreshed. By doing so, we reduce waste, save money, and foster a deeper connection with our belongings.
