Please follow these instructions to dispose of items that do not fit or belong in any cart or bin. Do not place extra trash in the recycle or compost carts or bins, this contaminates the recycle and compost streams. Refer to the sorting guide on the reverse-side.



### Bulky Item & Extra Trash Removal

#### *Retiro De Artículos Voluminosos*

Contact your property manager to arrange for free bulky item removal.



### Self-Haul Disposal Coupon

#### *Cupón De Auto-Recojo Disponible*

WM provides coupons for the disposal of up to two cubic yards of household garbage self-hauled to the Davis Street Transfer Station. A fee will be charged for large bulky items. No household hazardous waste. To request a coupon, call WM at (510) 537-5500 or pick up a coupon from Hayward City Hall or the WM office at 172 98th Ave, Oakland.



### Free Mattress Drop Off

#### *Entrega Gratuita De Colchones Y Somieres*

Residents and businesses can bring up to five mattresses or box springs per day to WM's Davis Street facility for free, Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at 2615 Davis Street, San Leandro, CA 94577. ### Used Household Batteries Collection

#### *Recolección De Las Baterías Gastadas*

### Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

#### *Desechos Domésticos Peligrosos*

Take hazardous items such as fluorescent bulbs, paints, stains, solvents, adhesives, garden and auto chemicals, batteries, electronic waste, to the Household Hazardous Waste Facility at 2091 West Winton Avenue, Hayward. ### Do Not Pour Fats, Oils, & Grease Down the Drain

#### *No Vierta Aceites, Grasas U Otros Lípidos En El Drenaje*

Cooking oils, shortening, dairy products, sauces and salad dressings do not belong down your drain because it can block sewer lines and cause overflows. Pour small amounts into a cardboard box, or absorb small amounts with paper towels or napkins and place in organics green cart of bin.
