Additional Carts

Recycling – EKUCA residential customers who regularly generate excess recyclables can request additional 96-gallon recycling carts for a monthly charge invoiced separately by WM.

Organic Waste – EKUCA residential customers who regularly generate excess organic waste can request additional 96-gallon organic waste carts for a monthly charge invoiced separately by WM.

Trash – EKUCA residential customers who regularly generate excess trash can request additional 96-gallon trash carts for a monthly charge invoiced separately by WM.



WM and Kern County are proud to present Eastern Kern Universal Collection Area residents with this updated service guide to your recycling, organic waste, and trash collection services to comply with California State Senate Bill (SB) 1383. Bulky item and Christmas tree pickup will begin the week of January 1st. Weekly organic service will begin the week of January 8th.

Residential Cart Service

EKUCA Standard Residential Service will include one 96-gallon recycling cart serviced every other week, one 96-gallon organic waste collection cart serviced weekly and one 96-gallon trash cart serviced weekly. A listing of which items may be placed in each container is noted in this guide and on the lid of each cart as are instructions on placing the carts for service.

From Kitchen to Cart - Tips for Separating Your Food Waste



Step 1

Find a bowl or bucket; Layer the bottom with newspaper or line it with a paper bag or approved compostable bag. Fill it with acceptable organic



Step 2

Empty contents into your WM organic waste cart prior to service.



Step 3

Wipe out any residual and spray with vinegar solution (if needed), let it dry and line with newspaper or paper bag.

Container Color Transition

California regulations under State Senate Bill (SB) 1383 require collection containers to be uniform across the state by 2036. In the Eastern Kern Universal Collection Area, the new cart color scheme will be as follows: recycling carts will have a blue lid, organic waste carts will have a green lid, and trash carts will have a black lid. While new carts will be delivered in this color scheme, existing carts will be transitioned gradually to minimize service disruptions. Make sure you check the lid or label for instructions on how to use your carts correctly and avoid contamination.



Recycling

• Your dark gray cart with a blue lid is for recycling collection. Place the following items loose in your cart, do not bag your recyclables.













Food & Beverage Cans

Do Not Include:

Food or Liquids, Plastic Bags or Film, Foam Containers, Clothing, Furniture, or Carpet, Batteries, Electronics, Hazardous Waste, Yard Waste

Organic Waste - Weekly Service begins Monday, January 8, 2024

• Your dark gray cart with a green lid will be organic waste collection. You may use a compostable bag that meets ASTM D6400 standards or place organic waste loosely in the cart.

Holidays

- Labor Day (First Monday in September)
- Memorial Day (Last Monday in May) • Independence Day (July 4)
- Thanksgiving Day (Fourth Thursday in November)
- Christmas Day (December 25)

Cart Service Reminders

- 1. Place all waste and recycling in the appropriate container and close the lid so that it fits tight to the cart body. Trash, organics, and recyclables left outside the carts will not be collected.
- 2. Place your carts at the curb by 6 a.m. on collection day. Emptied carts should be removed from curbside following service.
- 3. Roll carts into street and place them against the curb with the handles facing your home. Place carts at least three feet apart from other carts and objects.



ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Bulky Item Collection (Begins the week of January 1, 2024)

Each EKUCA residential customer is entitled to up to twelve (12) bulky item pick-ups per year, of up two (2) items per pick up, at no additional charge. Collection must be scheduled at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance of your regular service day. To get started and request your Customer ID, contact Customer Service at (661) 947-7197. Once you have your Customer ID, you can setup your My WM Profile on wm.com and schedule future bulky item pickups via the web or the My WM Mobile App for your Apple or Android device.

Acceptable Bulky Items: furniture (chair, mattress, sofa), appliances (dishwasher, microwave), electronic waste (TVs, computers), area rug

Unacceptable Bulky Items: household hazardous waste (such as paint, oil and batteries), tires, spas, pianos, vehicle parts, items requiring more than two persons to safely handle

Holiday Tree Collection (Begins the week of January 1, 2024)

EKUCA residential customers can recycle real and unflocked trees and wreaths during the first two service days following December 25 at no additional charge. Just place them at the curb on your service day. Trees longer than six (6) feet must be cut in half. Please remove all decorations including tinsel, lights, ornaments, and tree stands.
