Holiday Tree Recycling

Ridgecrest customers can recycle trees and wreaths during the first two service days in January at no additional cost! Just place them at the curb on your service day. Trees longer than six (6) feet must be cut in half. Please remove all decorations including tinsel, lights, ornaments and tree stands.



Community Recycling Bin & Soiled Waste Bin Available to Residents

The recycling bin and soiled waste bin are located inside the WM yard gates (237 County Line Rd) Monday - Friday from 7 a.m. - 4 p.m. and outside the gates for access on the weekend. During the week, please check in with the office staff prior to dropping off. The recycling bin is designated for flattened cardboard, bottles, cans, glass and paper (please do not place recyclables in plastic bags) and the soiled waste bin is available for diapers and animal waste.

Sharps

Residents can safely dispose of their sharps using WM's Sharps Mail Back Program. Contact Customer Service to order your kit. Drop offs can be made at the Ridgecrest Special Waste Facility on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month from 10 a.m. – 1 p.m. (Closed New Year's Day, Fourth of July, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day).

Household Hazardous Waste Disposal

Ridgecrest residents can dispose of HHW, such as household cleaners, pesticides, paint products, swimming pool chemicals and automotive fluids at the following Kern County Special Waste Facility:

Free Bulky Item Collection

Residents receive up to three (3)bulky item pick-ups with the maximum of 3 cubic yards or one bulky item per pick up, per year at no additional charge. Please schedule least 48 hours in advance of your regular service day. Schedule online at **home.wm.com/ridgecrest** or contact WM Customer Service.

Acceptable items include: furniture, appliances, tires, wrapped mattresses and electronics.

Non-acceptable items include: hazardous waste; machinery and industrial discards; oil, grease and other liquids; construction and demolition debris or excessively large items.

Holidays

WM observes the following holidays:

New Year's Day | Independence Day | Labor Day Thanksgiving Day | Christmas Day

When your collection day falls on/or after one of these holidays, your collection will be delayed by one day that week only. If a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delay.


