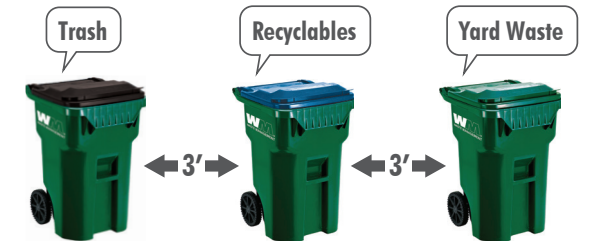

Bear-Proof Cart Service Available

A bear saver cart is designed to discourage bears from scavenging inside the container. These carts can be purchased (customer expense) by calling 530-546-3154 or e-mailing sales@bearbox.org.

Bag & Tag Stickers

Excess waste contained in a 32-gallon garbage bag (max. weight 40 lbs.) can be placed at the curb by using one of the 12 stickers (mailed annually). Place bag next to trash cart on your normal service day.

Vouchers

Customers that are current with their bill can access the McCourtney Rd. Transfer Station for free disposal of up to two cubic yards of solid waste one time per year. Must present voucher.

Single-Stream Recycling and Clear Bags

Your recyclables do not need to be bagged. However, if you place recyclables in a bag, you must use a clear bag.

WHAT TO DO WITH OTHER ITEMS



Batteries*, Fluorescent Bulbs & Electronics – call 530-274-0120 to recycle.



Hot Ash – wait until it cools, bag, then place in the trash.



Used Motor Oil & Filters** – Call 530-274-0120 for details on disposal.



Rocks, Dirt & Concrete – call 530-274-3090 to schedule a dumpster.



Plastic Bags – recycle at local grocery stores or bundle plastic bags, place them within another plastic bag and deposit the bag in the single-stream recycling cart.



Needles & Medical Waste – check with your local pharmacy.

*Recycle Household Batteries at the Curb:

If you have curbside service, household batteries may be placed on top of your trash cart in a zip lock bag on your regular collection day. The batteries will be collected along with your trash cart items.

**Curbside Oil and Oil Filter Program

At the request of a residential customer, used oil filters and motor oil will be collected in sealed containers provided free of charge by Waste Management. Please call or email Customer Service for delivery of the special oil container and filter bags. Used oil containers should be placed next to your recycle bin, on your designated recycle bin service day.
